

PURPOSE The UMFK Atł

The UMFK Athletic Hall of Fame is established to recognize the men and women who have distinguished themselves in the field of athletics by their performance on UMFK athletic teams, by their achievements in sports after graduation, or by their meritorious efforts on behalf of UMFK athletics.

### INDUCTION CRITERIA

### STUDENT ATHLETE

- Must be an alumnus/alumna of UMFK.
- Must have competed at the highest level of their sport(s). Consideration will be given to character, leadership, and non-athletic services to the University or community.

#### TEAM

- Must have competed with distinction at UMFK.
- Excelled at conference, regional, or national levels.

#### COACH/ATHLETIC ADMINISTRATOR

- Served as a head coach or assistant coach at UMFK.
  Exhibited leadership that enhanced UMFK's athletics
- programs.Strong support from players, teams and/or administrators.

#### **BUILDER/ADMINISTRATOR**

- Significant contributor to the development and/or enhancement of UMFK athletic programs other than as a coach athlete.
- Must have developed opportunities for students to excel.

### **NOMINATION GUIDELINES & CRITERIA**

#### Who may nominate a candidate for consideration?

- Any alumni or friend of UMFK athletics may make a nomination.
- Nominator must provide supporting information about the nominee.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Athlete must have graduated from UMFK
- Athlete must have contributed to the image of UMFK athletics.
- Nominees must receive at least 70 percent of the vote for induction.
- If not selected, a nominee will remain eligible for three years.

# HALL OF FAME NOMINEE SELECTION

## Criteria for Selection of a Student-Athlete Nominee

- Each student-athlete nominee must have played at least one year and finished his/her athletic career at UMFK.
- Each student athlete nominee must have demonstrated good citizenship both in school and after leaving UMFK.

### **Criteria for Selection of a Team Nominee**

- Team nominees must have won a conference, regional or national championship, or demonstrated outstanding performance. Other accomplishments will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Team nominees must have demonstrated good sportsmanship.

### Criteria for Selection of a Coach/Athletic Administrator

- Coach or athletic administrator nominees must have served UMFK for at least four years.
- Nominees must have served as a coach, administrator, manager, trainer, student-trainer, or otherwise contributed to the athletic program. Coaches/ administrators need not be UMFK alumni.

## Criteria for Selection of a Builder Administrator

- Individuals nominated must be a graduate of UMFK, faculty or staff member, or a friend of UMFK Athletics.
- Nominees made outstanding contributions to UMFK athletics.

### **Selection Committee**

The Committee will review and vote on nominees for induction in accordance with the eligibility requirements and criteria. The Committee will consist of:

- Director of Athletics, or designee
- Director Alumni Affairs, or designee
- Four UMFK Alumni (appointed by the UMFK Alumni Association)
- UMFK Sports Information Director
- All UMFK Head Coaches
- Student/Athlete (Appointed by coaches)
- Faculty Athletics Representative
- Faculty Member
