Adult Learners

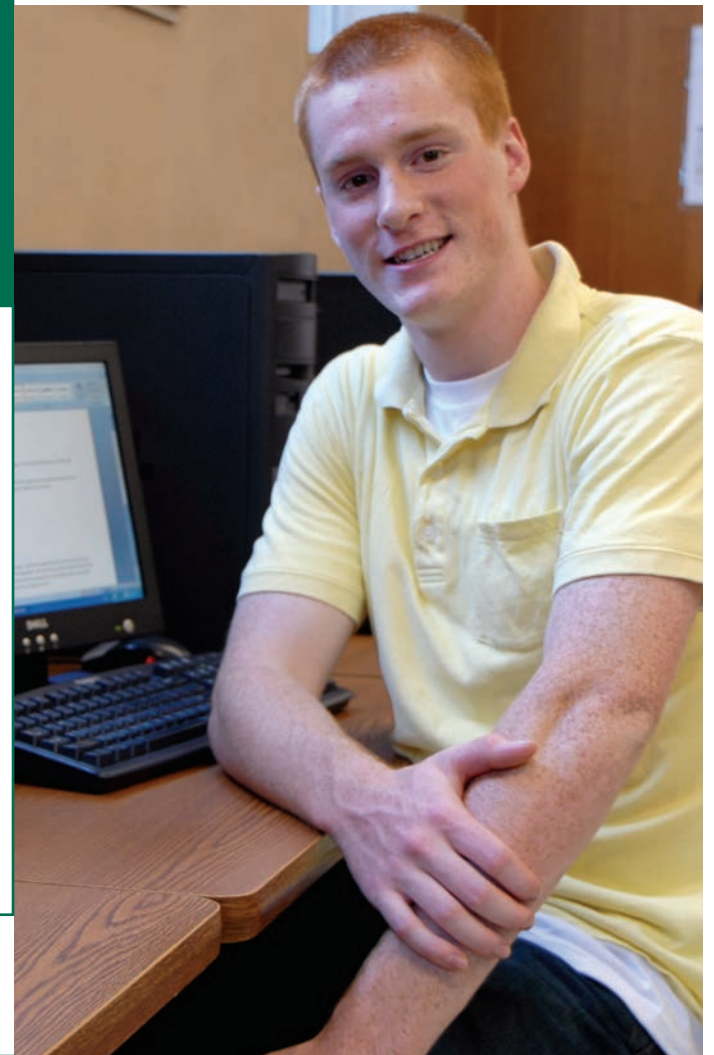
1. Final High School transcript or passing GED scores
